- Completing the AIPTLC English Placement Test to achieve an IELTS 5.5 or equivalent English proficiency; OR
- · Proof that the student has successfully completed an English Language course with an Australian educational institution exiting at an Upper Intermediate level; OR
- · Any AQF qualification at the Certificate III level or above in any discipline area delivered and assessed in English; OR
- Statement from an educational institution or similar evidence that confirms that English was the language of instruction if at least five years' studies completed in Australia, UK, USA, Canada, New Zealand, South Africa or Republic of Ireland.

Please note: All students must complete a Language, Literacy and Numeracy Test (LLN) during orientation. Students who do not complete an LLN during orientation will be required to complete one before the course commences to ensure the program's suitability and assist AIPT in identifying any additional support needed during their study.
